Services Provided To the Public

Medical Care Gregg County adult residents who qualify under the Indigent program (CIHCP).

This is for medical care, referrals to other medical facility or provider, medication, etc. Patients are eligible for a three-month period. Eligibility will be determined after an application process.

Hospital Bill Assistance Gregg County adult residents who qualify under the Indigent guidelines.

The patient bills incurred at a Gregg County hospital that are within 95 days prior to the client's application with Gregg County Health Department.

Pauper Cremation Assistance Indigent Gregg County residents who are deceased, the next of kin can apply for a pauper cremation if the decedent qualifies under the Indigent guidelines.

Utility Assistance Gregg County residents who have received a disconnect notice for electricity or gas and must apply and meet the criteria to obtain assistance.

Immunizations Children and adults who live in Texas and qualify under the TVFC Program. The clinic is open Monday through Friday from 8:30am until 11:30am and 1:00pm until 4:00pm. They are located in Room 103.

Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Testing / Treatment If you live in any county or state and need to be tested or treated for Chlamydia, Gonorrhea or Syphilis. Treatment for Trichomonas (we do not test for or treat Herpes or Genital Warts) Hours are Monday, Wednesday and Friday, sign in from 7:30am – 10:00am testing begins at 10:00.

HIV Rapid Testing and Counseling Wellness Pointe - Monday during our STD testing times.
Wednesday - Special Health Resources during our STD testing times.

Condoms These are available free to the public at our office.

Water Testing Kits Information and kits are in our office for the public to have their water tested and they send to NETPHD lab in Tyler.
